The following are the definitions for the Performance Fact Sheet:

" " means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.

" " is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.

" " is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.

" " is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.

" " is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).

" " is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.

" " means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.

" " means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, or are otherwise reported as deceased, incarcerated, or called to active military duty.

" _____ " is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

" _____ " is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.

" _____ " is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.

" _____ " is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.

" _____ " is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.

" _____ " is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.
