

Academic Achievement (Current Student) Bachelor's Scholarship February 2025

Summary	<p>All current University of Phoenix degree students who are actively enrolled in a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program who (i) have taken a minimum of 24 credits at the University of Phoenix and have at least 18 credits remaining in a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program; (ii) have an aggregate GPA of 3.75 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) in their current bachelor's degree program; (iii) have not had an unapproved break in attendance greater than 14 days in the last 365 days except for an approved leave of absence as of the scholarship deadline; and apply for this Academic Achievement Bachelor's Scholarship (Current Students) – February 2025 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and post attendance in a class between February 1st, 2025 and February 28th, 2025 ("Initial Attendance Window") will have the opportunity to be considered for one of 15 scholarships worth up to a maximum of \$2,000 each, distributed over 20 courses.</p> <p>NOTE: Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application.</p>
Application Deadline	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on February 1st, 2025. Applications must be completed and submitted online at www.phoenix.edu by 11:59pm MST February 28th, 2025 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
Eligibility Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services. 2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient. 3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner) of an employee of University of Phoenix or any other affiliate of University of Phoenix, Inc. 4. Applicant must be currently attending a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program. 5. Applicant must submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documentation by the Application Deadline. The completion of the application form does not create an obligation to award a scholarship to the applicant.
