

# Academic Achievement (Current Student) Master's Scholarship September 2024

| Section              | Description   |
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| Summary              | <p>All current University of Phoenix degree students who are actively enrolled in a University of Phoenix master's degree program who (i) have taken a minimum of 9 credits at the University of Phoenix and have at least 9 credits remaining in a University of Phoenix master's degree program; (ii) have an aggregate GPA of 3.85 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) in their current master's degree program; (iii) have not had an unapproved break in attendance greater than 14 days in the last 365 days except for an approved leave of absence as of the scholarship deadline; and apply for this Academic Achievement Master's Scholarship (Current Students) – September 2024 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and post attendance in a class between September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 and September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024 ("Initial Attendance Window") will have the opportunity to be considered for one of 15 scholarships worth up to a maximum of \$2,000 each, distributed over 11 courses.</p> <p>NOTE: Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application.</p>  |
| Application Deadline | <p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Applications must be completed and submitted online at <a href="http://www.phoenix.edu">www.phoenix.edu</a> by 11:59pm MST September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>   |
| Eligibility Criteria | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services.</li> <li>2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient.</li> <li>3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner) of an employee of University of Phoenix or any other affiliate of University of Phoenix, Inc.</li> <li>4. Applicant must be currently attending a University of Phoenix master's degree program.</li> <li>5. Applicant must submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documentation by the Application Deadline. The completion</li> </ol> |
