Selection Process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix. 2. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application along with any required and supporting documentation, which must be received on or before the Application Deadline. The University of Phoenix accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the instructions. 3. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, disability, veteran status, or any other category protected by federal, state, or local law. 4. The 200 scholarships will be awarded to the eligible applicants with the highest GPA that apply by the application deadline. In the event there are applicants with the same GPA, the applicant(s) with the earliest date of application will receive the scholarship. 5. The decision of the University of Phoenix is final and not subject to review. 6. Starting on April 1st, 2025, the University of Phoenix will begin the selection process for eligible qualified students. 7. Recipients will be notified no later than May 1st, 2025.
Scholarship Award Distribution and Timing	<p>The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The maximum Scholarship award is \$2,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student's tuition payments at a rate of \$185 per course until: (i) the student completes 10 courses, after which a final disbursement of \$150 will be applied
