

# The Phoenix Doctoral Scholarship March 2025

Section	Description
Summary	<p>All new students who i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix doctoral degree program; (ii) have three year's work experience and (iii) apply for this Phoenix Doctoral Scholarship – March 2025 (“Scholarship”) prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025, and March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025 (“Initial Attendance Window”) will receive a scholarship worth up to a maximum of \$3,000 each, distributed over eight courses.</p> <p>NOTE: Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application.</p>
Application Deadline	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Applications must be completed and submitted online at <a href="http://www.phoenix.edu">www.phoenix.edu</a> by 11:59pm MST March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025 (“Application Deadline”). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
Eligibility Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services.</li> <li>2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient.</li> <li>3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner) of an employee of University of Phoenix or any other affiliate of University of Phoenix, Inc.</li> <li>4. Applicant must apply and be admitted to a University of Phoenix doctoral degree program.</li> <li>5. Applicant must submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documentation by the Application Deadline. The completion of the application form does not create an obligation to award a scholarship to the applicant.             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. As part of the scholarship application, the applicant must certify that they have three years of work experience.</li> <li>b.
