

<p>Summary</p>	<p>All new students or students who have been out of attendance for over 365 days who i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix master's degree program; (ii) have three year's work experience and (iii) apply for this Phoenix Master's Scholarship – October 2022 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between October 1st, 2022 and October 31st, 2022 ("Initial Attendance Window") will receive a scholarship up to \$1,000 each.</p> <p>Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application</p>
<p>Application Deadline</p>	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on September 1st, 2022. Applications must be completed and submitted online at www.phoenix.edu by 11:59pm MST October 31st, 2022 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
<p>Eligibility Criteria</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services. 2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient. 3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner) of an employee of University of Phoenix or any other affiliate of University of Phoenix, Inc. 4. Applicant must apply and be admitted to a University of Phoenix master's degree program. 5. Applicant must submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documentation by the Application Deadline. The completion of the application form does not create an obligation to award a scholarship to the applicant.

	<p>a. As part of the scholarship application, the applicant must certify that they have three years of work experience.</p> <p>6. Applicant must post attendance to their first master's degree course within the Initial Attendance Window.</p>
<p>Selection Process</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix. 2. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application along with any required and supporting documentation, which must be received on or before the Application Deadline. The University of Phoenix accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the instructions. 3. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, disability, veteran status, or any other category protected by federal, state, or local law. 4. The decision of the University of Phoenix is final and not subject to review. 5. Starting on November 1st, 2022, the University of Phoenix will begin the selection process for eligible qualified students. 6. Recipients will be notified no later than December 8th, 2022.
<p>Scholarship Award Distribution and Timing</p>	<p>The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The maximum Scholarship award is \$1,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student's tuition payments at a rate of \$91 per course until: (i) the student completes 10 courses, after which a final disbursement of \$90 will be applied toward the eleventh course, thus maximizing the \$1,000 total Scholarship amount, or (ii) two years has elapsed from the student's first date of attendance in the their first course, or (iii) the student graduates from their program, whichever comes first. Subsections (i)-(iii) are collectively hereinafter referred to as "Terminating Events". 2. Only the applicants selected as Scholarship recipients will be notified by the University of Phoenix.
<p>Maintenance Requirements</p>	<p>In order to continue disbursement of the scholarship award, applicant must</p>
