



<p>Selection Process</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix.</li> <li>2. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application along with any required and supporting documentation, which must be received on or before the Application Deadline. The University of Phoenix accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the instructions.</li> <li>3. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, disability, veteran status, or any other category protected by federal, state, or local law.</li> <li>4. The decision of the University of Phoenix is final and not subject to review.</li> <li>5. Starting on February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025, the University of Phoenix will begin the selection process for eligible qualified students.</li> <li>6. Recipients will be notified no later than March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025.</li> </ol>
<p>Scholarship Award Distribution and Timing</p>	<p>The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The maximum Scholarship award is \$3,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student's tuition payments at a rate of \$273 per course until: (i) the student completes 10 courses, after which a final disbursement of \$270 will be applied toward the eleventh course, thus maximizing the total Scholarship amount, or (ii) two years has elapsed from the student's first date of attendance in the their first course, or (iii) the student graduates from their program, whichever comes first. Subsections (i)-(iii) are collectively hereinafter referred to as "Terminating Events".</li> <li>2. Only the applicants selected as Scholarship recipients will be notified by the University of Phoenix.</li> </ol>
<p>Maintenance Requirements</p>	<p>In order to continue disbursement of the scholarship award, applicant must meet the following maintenance requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicant must remain in a master's program (all coursework attended must be program applicable courses). Awards will only be applied to courses taken as part of their master's program, specific to the original program level award.</li> </ol>

  - h. Applicants receiving Military Tuition Rate

6. The Scholarship will automatically terminate if:
  - a. Applicant fails to meet the eligibility requirements
  - b. Recipient is Academically Disqualified, Disqualified for Admission, Scholastically Disqualified, Scholastically Suspended or Expelled as outlined in the University Catalog.
  - c. Recipient is out of attendance on an unapproved leave of absence for more than 35 days.
  - d. Recipient completes their master's degree program.
  - e. Receives the maximum scholarship award
  - f. 730 days from a recipient's first course.
